UNSAFE WATER ALERT

Oak Creek Intermediate School water is contaminated with E. Coli

DO NOT DRINK YOUR WATER

Failure to follow this advisory could result in illness.

E. coli bacteria were found in the water supply on January 13, 2017. These bacteria can make you sick, and are a particular concern for people with weakened immune systems. **DO NOT USE THE TAP WATER FOR DRINKING AND COOKING UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.**

What should I do?

- **DO NOT DRINK YOUR TAP WATER---USE ONLY BOTTLED WATER.** Bottled water should be used for all drinking (including baby formula and juice), brushing teeth, washing dishes, making ice and food preparation **until further notice.**
- **DO NOT TRY AND TREAT THE WATER YOURSELF.** Boiling, freezing, filtering, or letting water stand will not make the water safe.
- Bottled water is available for all students, staff and food service personnel. Dispensers are located in all classrooms, the office, the kitchen, and the Gymnasium.

We will inform you when tests show that the water is safe again.

DISCLOSURE: Be advised that Section 116725 and 116730 of the California Health and Safety Code state that any person who knowingly makes any false statement on any report or document submitted for the purpose of compliance with the attached order may be liable for a civil penalty not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for separate violation for each day that violation continues. In addition, the violators may be prosecuted in criminal court and upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than \$25,000 for each day of violation, or be imprisoned in the county jail not to exceed one year, or by both the fine and imprisonment.
